

## DD Form 2606 Wait List Information Sheet

It is the parents' responsibility to fully complete the Wait List Form 2606 and submit with a copy of their orders to the CDC or Family Child Care Coordinator. Priority determination will be made upon completion of DD Form 2606 Request for Care, unless space is available and no waiting list exists.

Priority determination will progress as follows:

- **Wounded Warrior**
- **Single Active Duty Military parent or Single DOD Civilian parent**
- **Dual Active Duty Military or Dual DOD Civilian parents**
- **Active Duty Military or DOD Civilian parent**

Our waiting lists are divided into:

- **Active Wait List** to include those families who will accept a space as soon as a space is available.
- **Unborn List** to include unborn children

As soon as the baby is born, it is the parents' responsibility to call and have the request for care form transferred to the active wait list and to include a potential date when care is needed.

Families PCSing to Grand Forks Air Force Base need to contact the CDC upon arrival and update the DD Form 2606 with their address and phone numbers. If the current information is not received, their child will be removed from the waiting list. Filling out a wait list form does not guarantee a slot. A family may go up or down on the list due to another family of higher priority signing up for or declining care. It is always recommended that families have backup care.
